Let's Play Grammar

Jump right!

Your teacher will divide the class into groups of five. She will have a box on her table with sentence cards in them. She will also have a pronoun mat laid out with the pronouns *he*, *she*, *it*, *they*, *we* and *you* written on it. She will call each group to the front of the class one by one. Each group member will take turns to pick a sentence card from the box and read aloud the sentence. He or she then has to jump on the pronoun on the pronoun mat that can correctly replace the noun in the sentence. Each member gets ten seconds. Each correct jump fetches the group one point. The teacher will say the correct answer if someone goes wrong. When all the members of the group have played, they hand over their cards to the teacher and go back to their seats. Now the next group comes. The game continues in this way until all the sentence cards have been used up. The group with the highest score at the end wins.
