The elephant carried the children on his back all over the village.

The coloured words are called articles. There are three articles in English: a, an and the.

Articles always come before nouns. However, in some cases, there may be other words present in between them.

a kite

a tall woman

a fresh orange

A and an are used to talk about things in general.

We use **a** and **an** when we talk about one noun only.

A is used when the word begins with a consonant sound. **An** is used when the word begins with a vowel sound.

Can you bring me **a** pen?

An apple is a nutritious fruit.

The is used to talk about a specific thing.

We went to **the** park today.

Here, we are talking about a particular park, not parks in general. Thus, the article **the** has been used.

The is also used to talk about something that has already been mentioned before.

I found **a** red basketball. **The** basketball looked new.

In the first sentence, **a** is used as we are referring to red basketballs in general. In the second sentence, **the** is used because we are talking about the specific ball that we mentioned before.

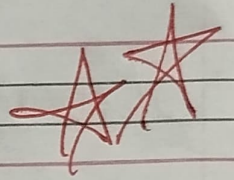
