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Learning Division

* Division of a number by 1

- 1 A number when divided by 1 gives the same number as the quotient

Example $450 \div 1 = 450$ and $1225 \div 1 = 1225$

* Division of a number by itself

- 2 A number when divided by itself gives the quotient as 1

Example $221 \div 221 = 1$ and $8650 \div 8650 = 1$

* Division of 0 by a number.

0 when divided by any number gives the quotient as 0

Examples $0 \div 82 = 0$ and $0 \div 394 = 0$



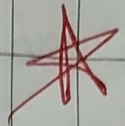
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* Division of a number by 0

it is not possible to divide a number by 0

If there are 3 women and every woman gets 4 gift vouchers, then together they get 12 gift vouchers.

$$4 \times 3 = 12$$

Thus, $3 \times 4 = 12$ and $4 \times 3 = 12$.

This shows that $12 \div 4 = 3$. Hence, for the division fact $12 \div 4 = 3$, the two multiplication facts are $3 \times 4 = 12$ and $4 \times 3 = 12$.

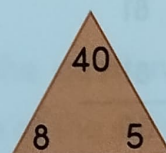
Multiplication facts

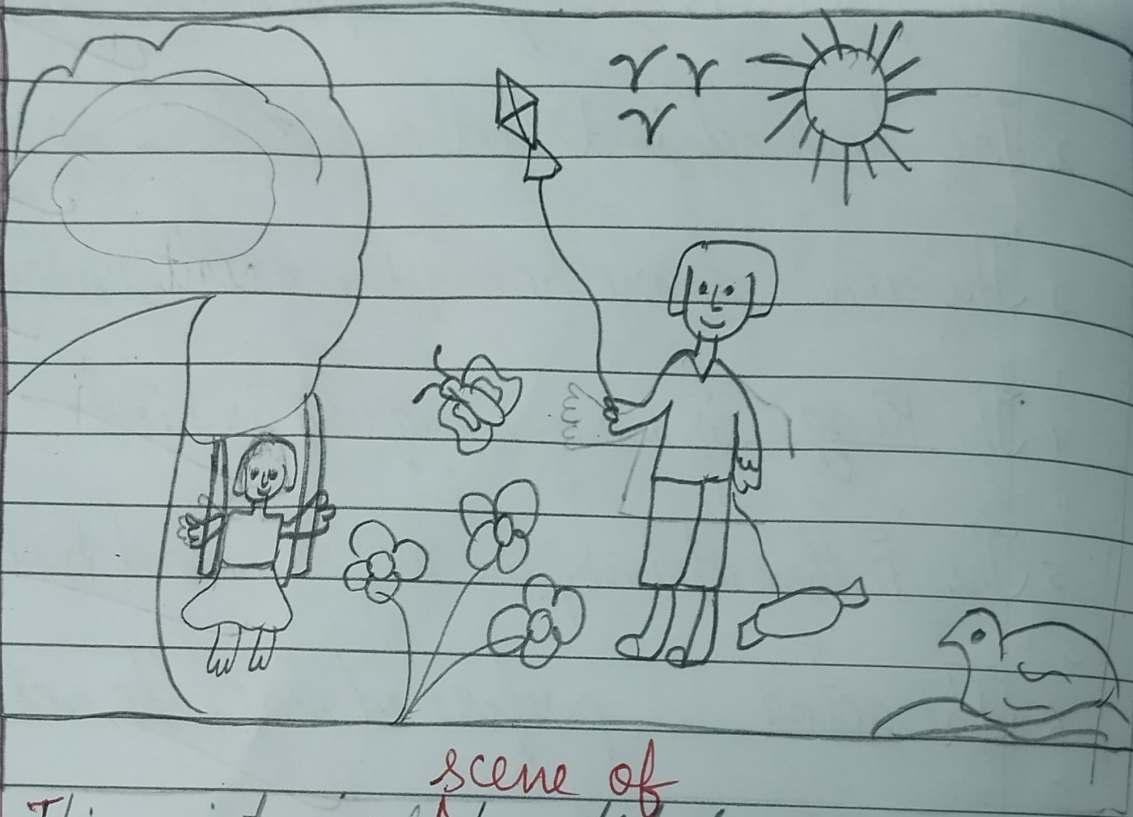
