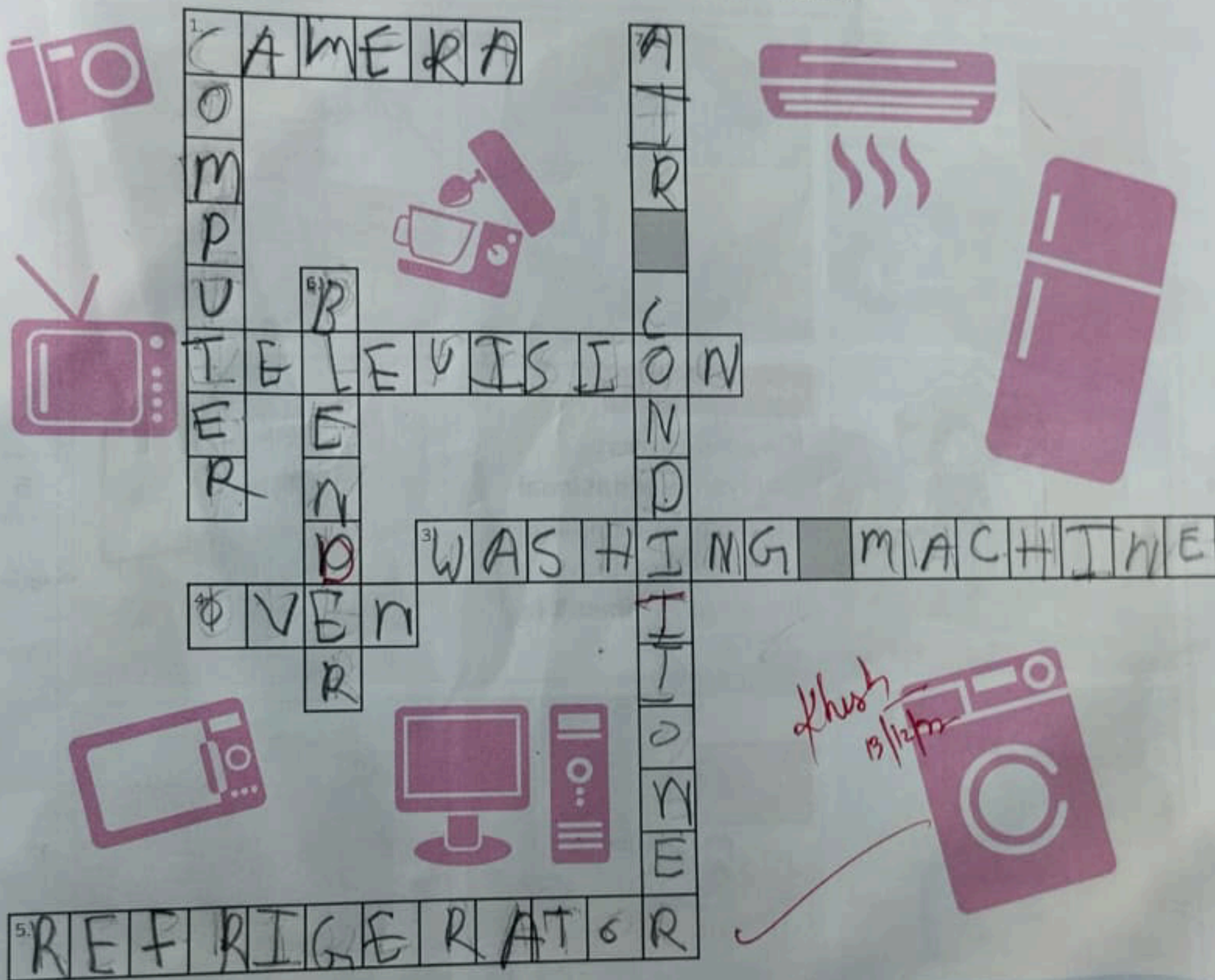

Adjectives That Show Belonging

Compare sentences 1 and 2 with sentences 3 and 4.

| 1. Timothy was a <i>brave</i> dog. | 3. This is <i>my</i> pen. |
| 2. Sita is a <i>naughty</i> girl. | 4. It is <i>her</i> car. |

In sentences 1 and 2, the words *brave* and *naughty* tell us more about the nouns *dog* and *girl* respectively. The words *brave* and *naughty* are adjectives.

Adjectives are usually placed before the noun they talk about. In sentences 3 and 4 the adjectives *my* and *her* tell us who the pen and car belong to.

This is *my* book.

My is an adjective. It tells us who the book belongs to.

My, your, his, her, its, our and *their* are adjectives which tell us who something belongs to. They are adjectives of possession.

Is *your* town far from Chennai?

Their car is very old.
