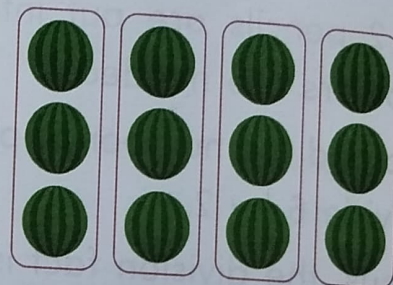

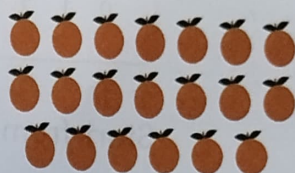

- When the noun ends with -y and the letter before last letter is a vowel, we add, s to make it plural.

- When a noun end in -y and the letter before last letter is a consonant, we drop -y and add -ies to make it plural.
