- (b) There are 45 sandwiches in a birthday party. 9 children share them equally. How many sandwiches does each child get?

$$45 \div 9 = 5$$

Each child gets 5 sandwiches.

- (c) Avantika has 56 stamps. She wants to paste equal number of stamps on each page of her album. There are 8 pages in her album. How many stamps can she paste on each page?

$$56 \div 8 = 7$$

She can paste 7 stamps on each page.

- (d) In a cricket match, 7 players made equal runs. If the total runs made by them were 35, how many runs did each player make?

$$35 \div 7 = 5$$

Each player made 5 runs.

$$\begin{array}{r} 5 \\ 7 \overline{) 35} \\ - 35 \\ \hline 00 \end{array}$$

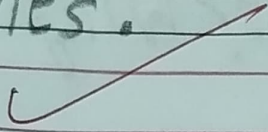

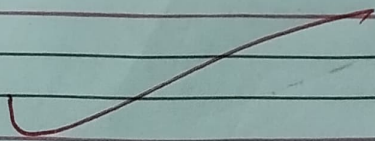

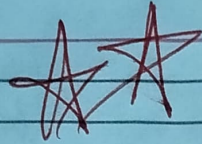
