Full Stop, Question Mark, Exclamation Mark

While speaking, we pause, stop and change the tone of our voice to make ourselves clear. This helps people understand what we are saying. In the same way, when we write, we use **punctuation marks** to make our writing clear and meaningful.

- We use a **full stop** (.) at the end of a statement (a sentence that tells something).
It may start raining any moment.
So, it would be better if we returned home.
- We use a **question mark** (?) at the end of a question.
Why did Shanti miss the audition?
Who was selected for the role?
- Some sentences show surprise, shock, excitement or another strong feeling. We use an **exclamation mark** (!) at the end of such sentences. We also use an exclamation mark after words like **ouch**, **hey**, **oh**, **alas** and **hurrah**.
Ouch! I hurt my ankle.
What a wonderful place!
