

We sometimes arrange words in the alphabetical order. Alphabetical is the order of letters in the alphabet. A, b, c, d, e, f and so on. Looki following alphabetical list of words:

baby, enemy, king, Raju, Thomas, Urdu, zebra

To put words in the alphabetical order, we look at the first letter of each To put words in the order their first letters come in the alphabet.

If two words begin with the same letter, we look at the second letter.

1. captain, clown, crown

In this list we looked at the second letter of each word – a comes before I, and comes before r in the alphabet.

2. ride, road, run

Look at the second letter of each word - i comes before o, and o comes before u in the alphabet.




