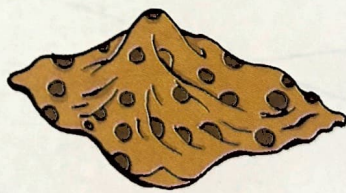

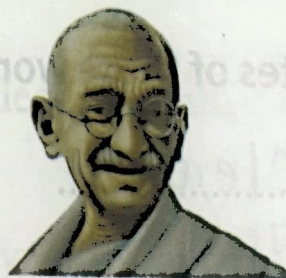

Alphabetical Order

We sometimes arrange words in the alphabetical order. Alphabetical is the order of letters in the alphabet. A, b, c, d, e, f and so on. Look at the following alphabetical list of words:

baby, enemy, king, Raju, Thomas, Urdu, zebra

To put words in the alphabetical order, we look at the first letter of each word and then arrange the words in the order their first letters come in the alphabet.

If two words begin with the same letter, we look at the second letter.

1. captain, clown, crown

In this list we looked at the second letter of each word – **a** comes before **c**, and **c** comes before **r** in the alphabet.

2. ride, road, run

Look at the second letter of each word – **i** comes before **o**, and **o** comes before **u** in the alphabet.

Random order : palace, please, pizza, poor

Alphabetical order : palace, pizza, please, poor

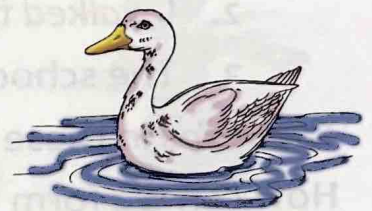

open ~ opened

paint ~ painted



Some other verbs form their past tense without following any rule.

come ~ came

write ~ wrote

buy ~ bought



- The simple past tense is used to show some action or activity in the past which is now over.

Sheila *called* Anita for help.

The train *stopped* suddenly.

- The simple past tense is used to show a past habit.

We usually *went* to school by bus.

The watchman *prayed* for two minutes every day before starting his work.
