





We can also add numbers using fingers. Let's add 3 and 4.

- Close your fists. Count the first number 3 on your left fist. Open 3 fingers on your left fist and keep folding the remaining.
- Now count the second number 4 using the remaining fingers.

  Open 4 more fingers.
- Count the total number of fingers. These are 7. Therefore 3+4=7.






### Addition Facts for 4

$$1 + 3 = 4$$

$$0 + 4 = 4$$

### Addition Facts for 5

There are 4 + 1 = 5 addition facts for 4 and 5 + 1 = 6 addition facts for 5.
