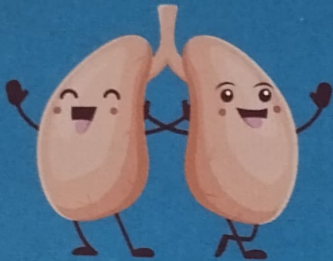


19 Vital Organs

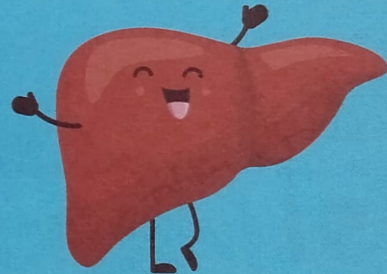
