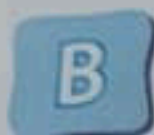

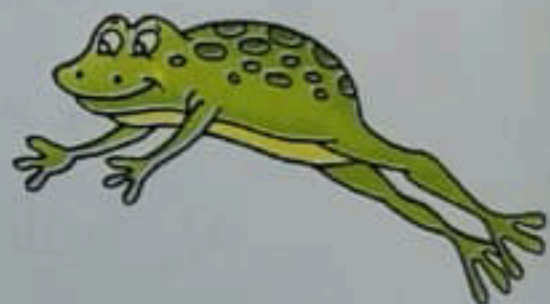

How are the questions formed?

They are formed by adding certain phrases such as *isn't she*, *hasn't she*, *can't you*, *doesn't he*, etc.

These additions are called question tags. Question tags are words added to the end of statements to turn them into questions.
